



Instructions for Creating a **Cryptra** Trial Key

The following are the instructions for creating your **Cryptra** Trial Key:

You will need the following:

1. A freshly formatted USB Flash Drive (32 megabytes or larger).
2. The CryptraTrial.exe software.
3. A computer system with a USB port.

Insert the USB Flash Drive into your system's USB port. Ensure that the flash drive has been recognized by the system and note the drive letter assigned to it.

Start the CryptraTrial.exe program and choose the defaults. When prompted for a USB flash drive, choose the letter of the drive that you just formatted. When the program finishes, your USB flash drive will be a **Cryptra** Trial Key. The USB flash drive's volume label should be "KR9T0001". The trial version requires this volume name.

This trial key contains the ready to run **Cryptra** program and the CryptraSetup program in a directory/folder named '\Cryptra'. The encryption key (OTP binary file) and associated files are located in the '\OTP' directory/folder. It is recommended that you run the CryptraSetup program to install the **Cryptra** software on your system. All data files will still be kept on the key.

Note: The Cryptra Trial Key contains a 5 megabyte OTP binary file of true random numbers for use with Cryptra. Since the trial key is available to everyone, encrypted files can be decrypted by anyone. DO NOT USE this trial key to encrypt or transmit files that you want kept secure and confidential. This trial key is for testing only.
